- ▶ Marshfield has played for the WIAA state title once (1940). The Tigers took second place.
- ▶ Since 1966, Neenah has played in 173 WIAA tournament games. Listed below are the results:
  - ◆ 70-23 in WIAA Regional competition, winning 28 titles.
  - ◆ 35-14 in WIAA Sectional competition, winning 14 sectional titles.
  - ◆ 18-13 in WIAA state competition, finishing 3rd in 1971, 2nd in 1969, 1970, 1972, 1988, 2014, and winning state titles in 1975 and 1978.

# Tonight's Matchup



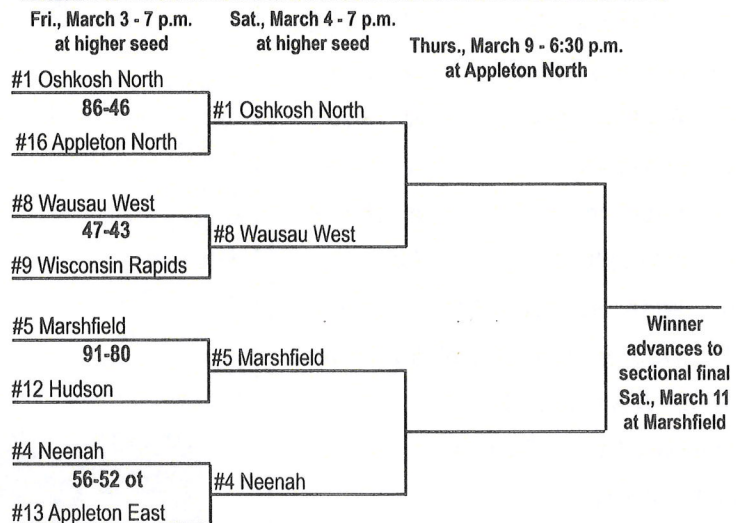
Good evening basketball fans and welcome to WIAA regional championship Saturday. Tonight, the fourth-seeded Neenah Rockets (15-8) welcome head coach Scott Scheuer (head coaching record of 29-17, second season as coach at Marshfield) and his fifth-seeded Marshfield Tigers (15-8) to the friendly confines of the Ron Einerson Fieldhouse. The winner of tonight's regional final will advance to play the winner of top-seeded Oshkosh North (23-0) and 8th-seeded Wausau West (10-13) next Thursday, March 9 at 6:30 pm at Appleton North.

The Tigers advanced to tonight's regional final by defeating the Hudson Raiders 91-80 in a high scoring affair last night in Marshfield. The Tigers enter tonight's game as a dangerous ball club with some significant momentum. They have won seven consecutive games and 12 of their last 14. Marshfield finished second in the Wisconsin Valley conference this year with an 8-4 conference mark (Stevens Point won the Wisconsin Valley with a 12-0 record). The Tigers are led in scoring by #1 Ethan Posteluk. The senior 6'1" guard averaged over 13 points per game for the Tigers this season. However, he isn't the only Tiger that the Rockets need to keep a close eye on tonight. Coach Scheuer is blessed with a talented, long and athletic lineup that has balanced scoring from four additional players that average between eight and 12 points. Those players are #12 Alec Hinson, #4 Reed Miller, #3 Seth Anderson, and #14 Grant Michaelis.

The Rockets punched their ticket to tonight's game by defeating the Appleton East Patriots in overtime 56-52 in a game that may be discussed for years to come. The Rockets trailed throughout the entire first half and took a nine-point deficit (26-17) into the locker room. The Patriots expanded their lead to 34-22 with 10:30 left, and even stretched it out to a game-high 14 points (39-25) with 8:17 left in regulation. The Rockets were lost on offense scoring only 25 points in the first 28 minutes of the game. To make matters even worse, Appleton East was dictating tempo and could get to the lane any time it wanted for a high percentage shot. Then, Big Red put on a comeback from the dead that even Lazarus would have been impressed with. In one of the more exciting comebacks that the hallowed walls of the Ron Einerson Fieldhouse have witnessed during the last 45 years of WIAA tournament action, the Rockets went on a 14-1 tear to cut the Patriot lead to 40-39 with 4:23 left in regulation. Neenah eventually tied the game at 45-45 with under a minute left in second half. However the Rockets couldn't convert on offense and Appleton East senior Matt Polfuss made some clutch free throws to take a 48-45 lead with 15.8 seconds left in regulation. Neenah senior guard Josh Mericle buried a baseline three-point shot to tie the game with under five seconds left. Fortunately for the Rockets, Appleton East dribbled up the court quickly and fired up a 20-foot shot while never noticing two Patriots open under the basket waiting for a pass. Once the Rockets received a second life with the opportunity for overtime, the Men of Rabas took advantage by outscoring the Patriots 8-4 and winning 56-52. Interestingly, this is the third consecutive season that Neenah has played a WIAA tournament game during the regional round that ended up in overtime. During the 50 previous seasons prior to 2015, the Rockets had played in a number of overtime games during the WIAA tournament series, however most of them occurred at the sectional or state level. Only two of those overtime games happened at the regional level and both in the Armstrong/Ron Einerson fieldhouse (1985 regional final 58-54 win over Oshkosh West and the 2002 regional final 73-67 win over Oshkosh North).

Hall of Fame basketball coach Bob Knight used to have a philosophy he would share with his teams during their many successful runs through the NCAA tournament. He called it "last game/next game." The concept is quite simple. It means that once you win a tournament game to advance, you need to immediately put that game behind and focus everything on the upcoming opponent. The handshakes, hugs, and pats on the back mean absolutely nothing if you don't do your job well and take care of your business the next evening against your next opponent. Previous accomplishments don't earn you anything on the scoreboard in the next game. In a single elimination tournament, the teams that advance usually don't do it with fancy plays. They win by eliminating mistakes and out executing their opponent. The Rockets were fortunate last night to advance while not playing their best. They will need to play at a much higher level of execution tonight if they want to extend their season and earn a ticket to the WIAA sectionals.
