- ▶ Neenah has played for the WIAA state title 10 times (1920, 1930, 1939, 1969, 1970, 1972, 1975, 1978, 1988, 2014). The Rockets have won three titles (1930, 1975, 1978).
- ▶ Appleton East has played for the WIAA state title twice (1986 and 1990). Both times the Patriots took second place.
- ▶ Appleton East has not made it out of the WIAA regional round since advancing to State in 2011.
- ▶ With two wins this weekend, Neenah can earn its 29th WIAA Regional title in its last 52 seasons of basketball.

Tonight's Matchup



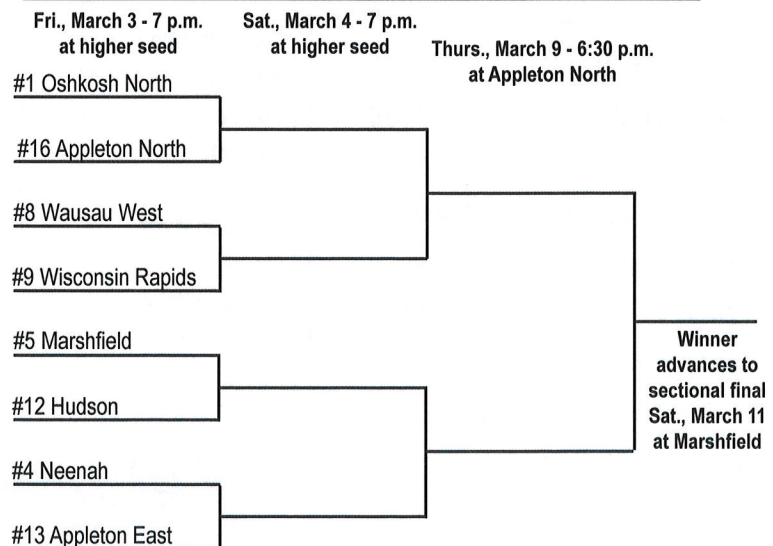
Good evening basketball fans and welcome to March Madness. Tonight the #4 seeded (14-8) Neenah Rockets welcome a very familiar foe from the FVA, head coach John Mielke and his #13 seeded (6-16) Appleton East Patriots. These two longtime rivals will battle in the Ron Einerson Fieldhouse tonight, tipping off the beginning of the 2017 WIAA boys' basketball tournament. The winner of tonight's regional semifinal will face the winner between #5 seeded Marshfield and #12 seeded Hudson. If the Rockets defeat the Patriots tonight, tomorrow night's WIAA Regional final will be played in the Ron Einerson Fieldhouse at 7:00 pm. If Appleton East defeats Neenah, the winner between Marshfield and Hudson will host the Patriots tomorrow night at 7:00 p.m. for the regional final.

The coaches and players from Appleton East are certainly no stranger to the Rockets. Coach John Mielke just concluded his 17th season as head coach of the Patriots. It has been a season of career benchmarks for the former 1977 Appleton West Terror standout. Earlier this season Coach Mielke earned his 200th career victory at Appleton East, and a week ago he notched his 350th high school coaching victory. Another familiar face on the Appleton East staff is Neenah graduate Steve Coenen. Coenen was a first-team all conference player for Coach Einerson's 1981 FVA championship team that finished 19-3. The Patriots enter tonight's game with some momentum, having won two out of their last four games. The Patriots turned back the Wildcats of Oshkosh West on Valentine's Day 51-33, and then defeated their cross city rivals, the Terrors of Appleton West, last Tuesday 70-62. The Patriots have been led in scoring this season by sophomore #24 Kaden Clark. The 6'3" forward averages 12 points per game. However, Coach Mielke also has a collection of four seniors that he has depended upon this season for offensive production. Seniors #4 Nathan Brice, #11 Matt Polfuss, #20 Blair Murphy-Pociask, and #22 Jason Gurholt, all average between eight and 11 points per game.

The Rockets enter tonight's game victorious in nine of their last 10 games. Last Thursday the Men of Rabas had their most impressive victory of the season when they went into #4 ranked Kimberly, on Senior Night, and stunned the Papermakers 56-55. This recent run has been Neenah's most extended stretch of success since the conclusion of the 2015 season when they won 10 of their last 11 before losing to SPASH in the sectional semifinal. The only team to have defeated Neenah since January 22 is the undefeated #1 ranked team in the state, the Oshkosh North Spartans. The Rockets finished their FVA season at 11-7 and tied for fourth place. Congratulations to Coach Rabas, his staff, and the team on being the biggest surprise in the FVA this season.

There are three parts to every season, non conference, conference, and the postseason. Two weeks from tonight every young man's dream is to be playing at the Kohl Center in the WIAA state tournament. The month of March can be exciting and it can also be cruel and unforgiving. For one team tonight, the dream will be over. In a single elimination tournament, the only guarantee promised to both teams is 36 minutes of playing time. The team that executes at a higher level will win the game, not necessarily the team that is higher seeded or has more perceived talent. As all Neenah fans should know, this is a Patriot team that cannot be taken lightly. Neenah blew a double-digit second half lead in a loss to Appleton East on December 2. The rematch on January 24 was a nip and tuck battle for 36 minutes that ultimately was decided when the Rockets hit a shot late in the game, and the Patriots missed one. As amazing as Neenah's run has been during the past five weeks, there is one thing to remember. In each of those nine wins, there have been moments when the Rockets have struggled to execute on the offensive and defensive end during those wins. Tonight it will take 36 minutes of "Big Boy" basketball to earn the victory. The smallest detailed mistake, a moving screen, a missed block out, a bad shot, a careless turnover, not hustling back on defense, a foolish foul, could spell doom and be the difference between playing tomorrow night for a regional championship or turning in your basketball equipment for the 2016-17 season.
